COLLECTION HIGHLIGHT

MAIL SLOT WINDOW FOR PLAINSBORO POST OFFICE, EARLY 20TH CENTURY

The first Plainsboro Post Office was located at the northwest corner of Plainsboro and Dey Roads. It moved to a second location on the south side of Plainsboro Road east of Edgemere Avenue. This window was recovered from the second location. The Post Office would move twice more, first to 410 Plainsboro Road where the Village Store is at present, and lastly to 12 Schalk's Crossing Road where it still operates today.
