COLLECTION HIGHLIGHT

PEW FROM BETHEL METHODIST CHURCH CA. 1815

The Bethel Methodist Church was built in 1812 on Plainsboro Road as the first church building erected in Plainsboro. The church closed in 1909 and the building was demolished in 1936. The cemetery can still be visited today and is maintained by the Township of Plainsboro.
